- 1 - Power saw operator;

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- 1 - Pump operator;
- 1 - Certified Wildfire Danger Tree Assessor.

Crew Leader

Successful completion of the following:

- a) S 100 Basic Fire Suppression and Safety or equivalent (annual re-currency);
- b) S 185 Fire Entrapment Avoidance;
- c) S 212 Fire Line Communications or Restricted Radio Operators Licence;
- d) S 230 Introduction to Supervision (Crew Boss);
- e) S 235 Burn Off and Backfiring;
- f) Incident Command System (ICS 100);
- g) Acted as Crew Leader on three (3) fires OR twenty (20) days as a fire fighter (minimum 240 hours required);
- h) Annual Physical Fitness Test – Moderate Standard

Fire Fighter

Successful completion of the following:

- a) S 100 Basic Fire Suppression and Safety or equivalent (annual re-currency);
- b) S 185 Fire Entrapment Avoidance;
- c) Five (5) certifiable days (12 hours per day) actively involved in fire fighting;
- d) Annual Physical Fitness Test – Moderate Standard.

Trainee Fire Fighter

Successful completion of the following:

- a) S 100 Basic Fire Suppression and Safety or equivalent (annual re-currency);
- b) S 185 Fire Entrapment Avoidance;
- c) Does not have five (5) certifiable days or sixty (60) hours fire fighting;
- d) A Trainee Fire Fighter will be allowed as per the following:
 - 5 person crew – 2 (one of which can be under the age of 18)
- e) Annual Physical Fitness Test – Moderate Standard

Power Saw Operator

Successful completion of the following:

- a) Qualified Fire Fighter as detailed above;
- b) Successful completion of a basic chainsaw operator's course or demonstrated experience as a
- c) chainsaw operator;

Danger Tree Assessor

Successful completion of the following:

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- a) Qualified Fire Fighter as detailed above;
- b) Certification as a Danger Tree Assessor – Wildfire Module;

Danger Tree Faller

- a) Certified to a standard acceptable to WorkSafe BC to fall trees in a forestry operation; Proof of Certification such as a wallet card will be required (i.e. Enform Level III – Faller Evaluation or BC Forest Safety council).
- b) Minimum of five (5) years experience falling in similar conditions to those anticipated when accepting a Drawdown; (Resume or log books are acceptable proof of this)
- c) Qualified Fire Fighter as detailed above.
